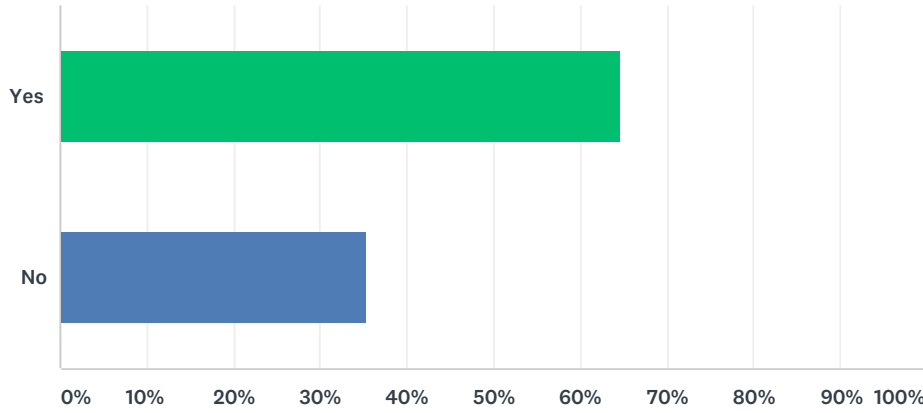


## Q1 Did you attend the January 9 Active Transportation Meeting?

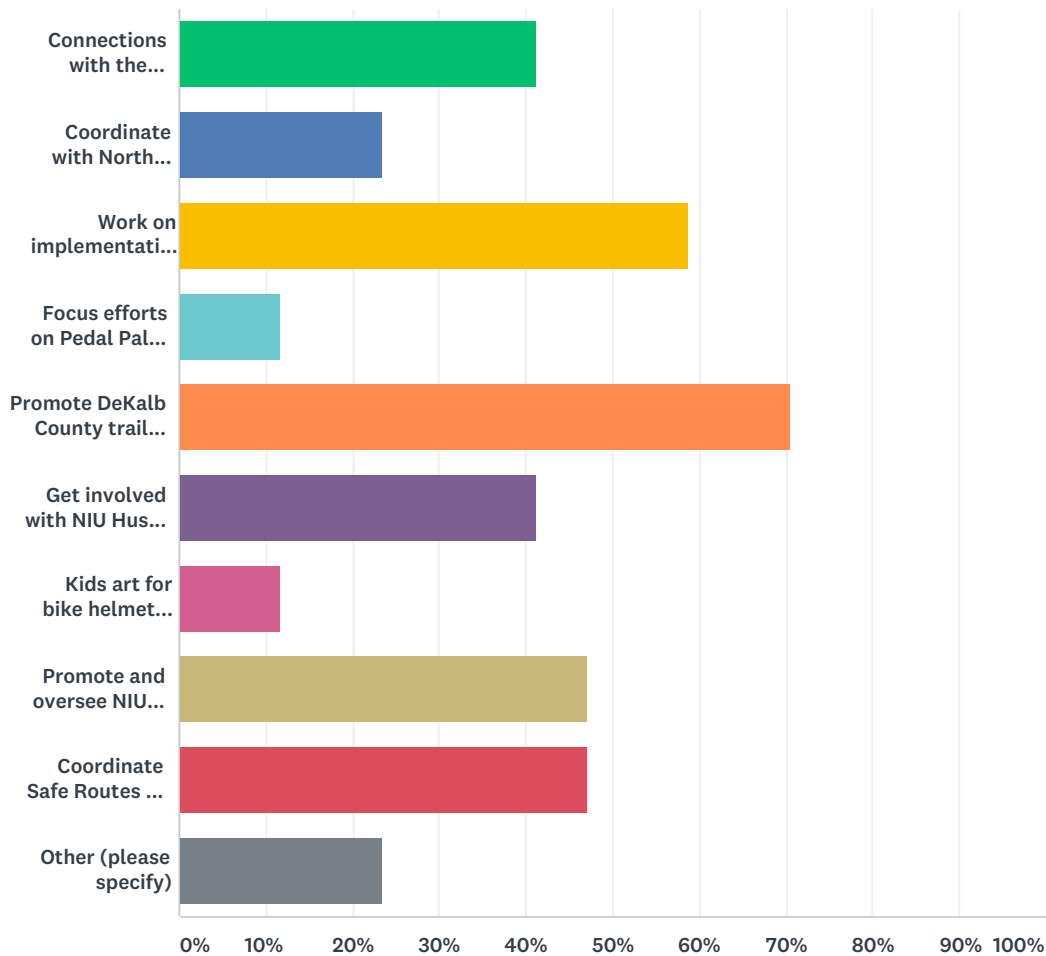

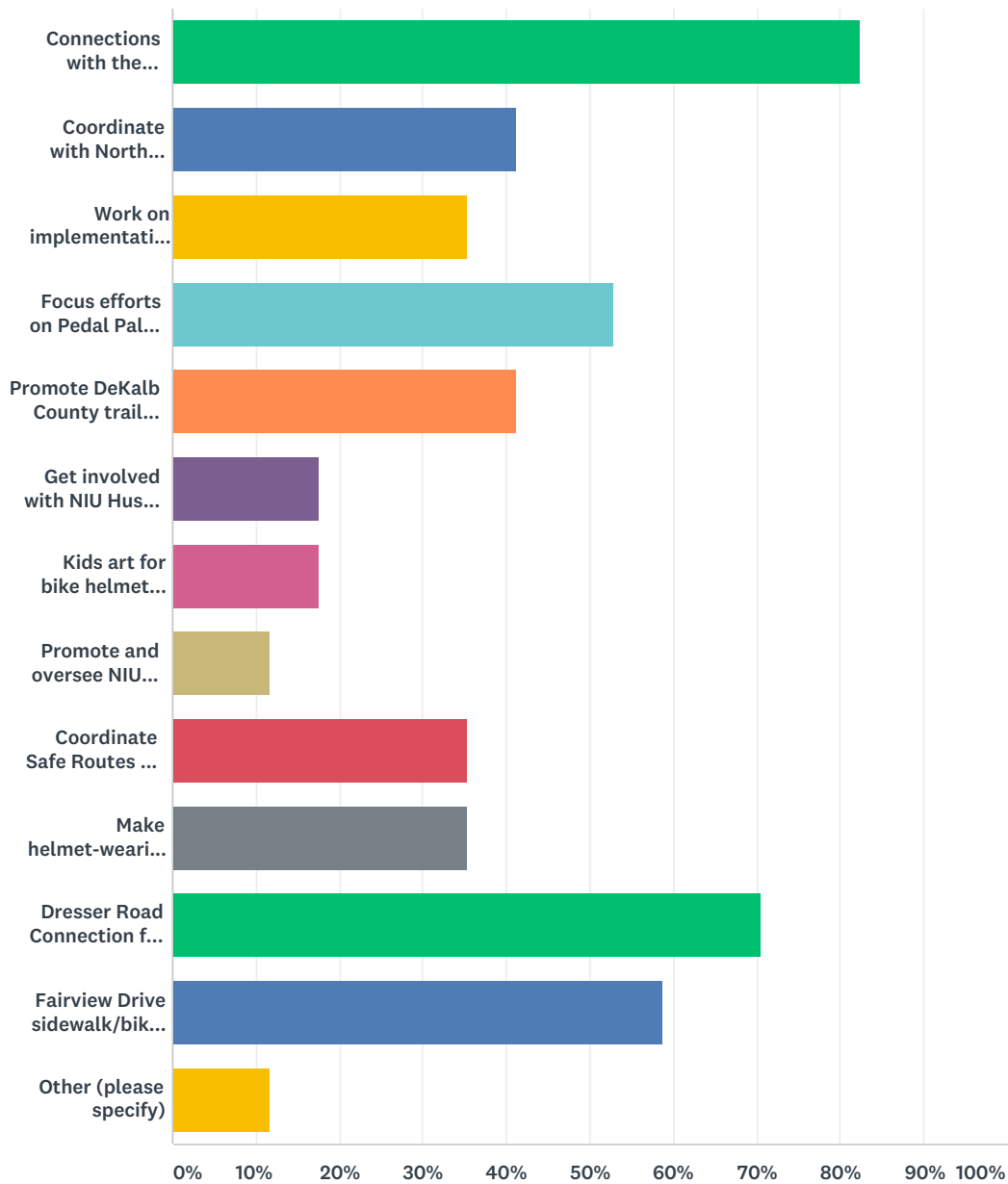
